### News in the U.S. Church

- Contraceptives, guns, and chicken: Christianity Today compiles end-of-the-year lists. (1)
- Top ten news stories from Christianity Today. ① The first: "Christian colleges and for-profit businesses sue over the Obama administration's narrow religious exemption to its insurance requirements for birth control, including emergency contraceptives."
- Colin Hansen's biggest theology story was the rising favorable tide for same-sex marriage. See his top 10.
- Chuck Colson passed away. See various obituaries. (1)
- James MacDonald resigns from the Gospel Coalition.
- John Piper to retire from Bethlehem Baptist Church and be succeeded by Jason Meyer. (1)
- Olympic gold medalist Gabby Douglas attended an EFCA church while training.

### Issues and Trends in the U.S. Church

- The year 2012 in numbers. 1 For example, 26% of Americans identify themselves as Evangelical.
- Six reasons young people are leaving the church. ① One reason is **shallowness on the part of the church**.
- How Christians voted for president.
- Mormonism becomes more acceptable, though almost 1 in 3 Americans don't know Mitt Romney is one. Franklin Graham believes calling Mormonism a cult hinders connecting with Mormons.
- The changing shape of **temptation**. ① Millennials are tempted by procrastination, Busters by worry, and Boomers by overeating.

#### Items related to missions

- Persecution of Christians has increased in Africa and decreased in China.
- Missions-related news is the new focus of a site launched by Fuller School of Intercultural Studies.
- The blog by Dr. Robert Priest has thought-provoking posts on missiology topics.
- Giving increased by 5.4% to international missions, 3.2% to domestic missions, and 21% to short-term missions. ①
- A study of the **cost of living** in 2012 compared 72 cities and 58 countries. ① Oslo, Zurich and Tokyo are the most expensive.
- Wycliffe was challenged regarding the non-use of familial terms for Jesus. (1)

#### Items related to missions (continued)

- Missio Nexus, a merger of The Mission Exchange and CrossGlobal, was launched in February, making it the largest Evangelical network in North America.
- The Freedom From Religion Foundation filed a federal lawsuit challenging the tax-exempt status of churches and "certain other religious organizations."
- Missionary statesman David Mays passed away. (1) (1)
- Dr. Edwin L. Frizen, who worked with various missionary organizations, passed away.

#### Media

- Free lectures on iTunes from three seminaries.
- The top ads of 2012. The most popular was a video calling for the arrest of warlord Joseph Kony of Uganda.
- The **Twitter year in review**, (1) including "Four more years," from Barack Obama, the most re-tweeted tweet of all time.

- The **top automotive trends** included pickup trucks as the two top selling models. ① Alternate fuel cars took 3.3% of the market share. ①
- Twelve new buzzwords, including "advertainment," "phablet," and "growth hacker." (1)
- The shift to Internet usage caused *The Encyclopedia Britannica* to discontinue its print version. (1)
- A growing trend is **asset-light living**, using mobile devices to buy goods, order in services, buy groceries, listen to music, watch TV, read books, travel, etc. ①
- Chick-fil-A restaurant became a focal point of the definition of marriage debate.

- Consumerism trends included themed hotels and minimalism.
- Consumerism trends differed for different age groups.
- 2012's predicted business trends for 2013 included a growing middle class.
- USA Today said that "2012 may well have been the Year of the Cheater."
- Restaurant trends included more locally-produced food, more healthy meals, more kids' meals, and more sustainability. (1)
- 10 health trends we don't want to see in 2013, including the supplement Raspberry Keytones. (1)
- Fitness trends included body weight training (1) and parkour. (1)
- Fashion trends included peplum silhouettes.
- Yahoo.com's interest trends, including Whitney Houston and the 2012 U.S. election. ①
- Google.com's interest trends, including top political gaffes (Big Bird) and top stocks (Facebook). (1)

## Technology

- The top technology stories of the year from The Washington Post, including Windows 8. 1
- CES 2013 displayed the **best in new consumer electronics**, including Microsoft's gaming tablet "Razer Edge", and the "YotaPhone," a half e-reader and half smartphone device. (1)
